

Standard turnaround time is 5-7 working days. Samples received after 3:00 PM will be considered as received on the next business day. Changes in scope of work by the client may result in changes in project cost and turnaround time.

Expedited services for rush turnaround is available on a pre-arranged basis. Surcharges for rush TAT will be applied to the analysis fee as follows:

4 Business Day: 20%,  
3 Business Day: 50%,  
2 Business Day: 75%,  
1 Business Day: 100%

The laboratory will make its best effort to meet mutually agreed upon TATs. The laboratory reserves the right to modify its TAT commitment based upon changes made by the client to the sample delivery schedule.

Pricing includes all bottles, preservatives and coolers, as well as bottle delivery and sample pickup within American Analytical's guidelines. Sample pickups and deliveries should be scheduled with 24 hours notice, and are based on the availability of American Analytical's courier staff.

Other miscellaneous fees:

For NY, NJ, and PA soil samples collected for Volatile Organic analysis must be collected with MeOH kits (\$25.00 per kit) or Encore Samplers. Samples should be received by laboratory the same day of sample collection. Please coordinate shipping arrangements with laboratory in advance of sample collection.

Some general wet chemistry tests for water samples have short hold times (such as Hexavalent Chromium at 24 hours, BOD, CBOD, MBAS, Nitrate, Nitrite, Ortho Phosphate, Settleable Solids and Turbidity at 48 hours). Please coordinate shipping arrangements with the laboratory in advance of sample collection.

Samples are retained by the laboratory for a period of 30 days, after which non-hazardous samples are disposed. The laboratory reserves the right to return hazardous or highly toxic samples and containers to the client.

Invoices are due and payable 30 days from date of invoice. Other project specific payment terms must be agreed to in advance. If credit terms have not been established, client will be placed on a COD basis, and payment will be expected before release of results to client.
